UTILITY COMMISSION MINUTES

The regular monthly meeting of the Utility Commission was held at the Village Hall, 352 High St, on Tuesday **07/05/16** and was called to order at 6:03 pm by Village Trustee Scott Reignier.

Motion by S Byers, second by T Schaeuble to open the monthly Utility Commission meeting. Motion carried. (Opened 6:04 pm).

The June 2016 Utility Report as submitted by Public Works Travis Coenen is as follows:

Water Utility:

1. Gallons pumped thru June 29th – 5.274 million gallons, daily average 181,862.
Well 4 static level – 116’ Pumping level – 288’
Well 2 static level – 100’ Pumping level – 182’

Sewer Utility:

1. Gallons treated as of June 29th – 6.4136 million gallons, daily average of 221,159
2. We received 45,600 gallons of holding tank waste and 30,500 gallons of septic tank waste thru June 29th. The revenue for the month of June so far is \$1,702.84, bringing the YTD total revenue to \$4,701.14.

T Coenen indicated Green Bay water is scheduled to start flowing into our system next Monday, July 11th. We will start with flushing the water main. Water softeners will need to be adjusted accordingly.
