UTILITY COMMISSION MINUTES

The regular monthly meeting of the Utility Commission was held at the Village Hall, 352 High St, on Tuesday **08/02/16** and was called to order at 6:36 pm by Village President Dean Erickson.

The July 2016 Utility Report as submitted by Public Works Travis Coenen is as follows:

Water Utility:

1. Gallons pumped thru July 10th – 1.653 million gallons, daily average 165,300.
Well 4 static level – 110’ Pumping level – 286’
Well 2 static level – 100’ Pumping level – 146’

Sewer Utility:

1. Gallons treated as of July 27th – 4.9438 million gallons, daily average of 183,104.
2. We received 35,800 gallons of holding tank waste and 41,750 gallons of septic tank waste thru July 27th. The revenue for the month of July so far is \$2,009.90, bringing the YTD total revenue to \$6,953.33.

T Coenen stated that the Water Transmission Main was going good and if residents needed help adjusting their water softeners they should give Public Works a call.
