UTILITY COMMISSION MINUTES

The regular monthly meeting of the Utility Commission was held at the Village Hall, 352 High St, on Wednesday **04/06/16** and was called to order at 6:09 pm by Village President Dean Erickson.

The March 2016 Utility Report as submitted by Public Works Travis Coenen is as follows:

Water Utility:

1. Gallons pumped thru March 30th – 3.869 million gallons, daily average 161,208.
Well 4 static level – 132’ Pumping level – 281’
Well 2 static level – 96’ Pumping level – 201’

Sewer Utility:

1. Gallons treated as of March 30th – 5.4901 million gallons, daily average of 228,754.
2. We received 41,900 gallons of holding tank waste and 2,000 gallons of septic tank waste in March. The revenue for the month of March is \$575.31, bringing the YTD total revenue to \$1,233.92.

T Coenen responded to a question that there is one mile left of pipeline to install.
