

**VILLAGE OF WRIGHTSTOWN**  
**UTILITY COMMISSION MINUTES**

The regular monthly meeting of the Utility Commission was held at the Village Hall, 352 High St, on Tuesday **05/03/16** and was called to order at 6:00 pm by Village President Dean Erickson with all reciting of the Pledge of Allegiance.

Motion by Q Cavanaugh, second by S Byers to open the monthly Utility Commission meeting. Motion carried. (Opened 6:00 pm).

The April 2016 Utility Report as submitted by Public Works Travis Coenen is as follows:

**Water Utility:**

1. Gallons pumped thru April 27th – 5.383 million gallons, daily average 199,370.  
Well 4 static level – 113’ Pumping level – 294’  
Well 2 static level – 96’ Pumping level – 179’

**Sewer Utility:**

1. Gallons treated as of April 27th – 7.5224 million gallons, daily average of 278,607.
2. We received 27,300 gallons of holding tank waste and 6,000 gallons of septic tank waste as of April 27th. The revenue for the month of April so far is \$556.04, bringing the YTD total revenue to \$1,808.11.

T Coenen commented that the 2015 Water Transmission Main project wrapped up last week Thursday and the pipe is all in the ground. There is still some work with calibration of meter stations before we get Green Bay Water here. S Johnson, S Byers and T Coenen met with Brown County Port Authority and they are designing a new landfill facility in the Town of Holland. The construction will begin in 2020 and they are looking for a place to bring their landfill water run offs. This may provide a revenue stream for the Village’s Waste Water facility.

Motion by T Schaeuble, second by Q Cavanaugh to close the monthly Utility Commission meeting. Motion carried. (Adjourned 6:05 pm).
